Teams work on cutting fabric, sewing and adjusting costumes



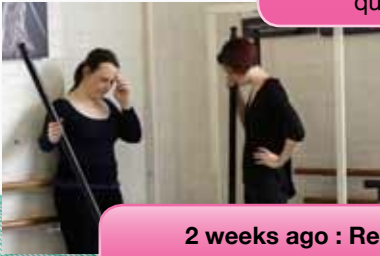
**2 months ago : Shaping**

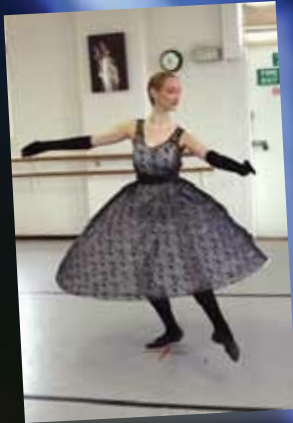
